At JPS, we believe that our uniform is essential to the ethos of our school, as it establishes a clear sense of identity, fosters a sense of inclusive belonging and engenders both positive behaviour and self-discipline, which in turn supports teaching and learning.

2. Purpose of policy

The purpose of the JPS Uniform Policy is to provide additional opportunities for increased school safety, to encourage our students to experience a greater sense of school identity and belonging, to encourage an improvement in student behavior, to reduce school clothing costs, to encourage a high level of program participation and to improve and expand academic excellence.

3. Aims and objectives

The goal of the Uniform Policy is that students present themselves in a clean and neat manner as a representation of JPS. While we recognize the uniqueness of each student and seek to develop individuality, it is also important for each student to understand the concept of appropriate dress for particular situations.

4. Dress Code

Hair:

For health and safety reasons, hair that falls below shoulder-length must be tied back fully off the face in one or two braids or ponytails held by a plain white, dark blue or black elasticated band. The sensible use of hair

accessories is acceptable to keep hair orderly and neat e.g. JPS hairband, JPS scrunchy and/or plain white/dark blue/black clips, slides, elasticated bands etc.

Hair must be no shorter than a number two barber cut. Patterns shaved into the hair are not acceptable.

Students' hair must be neat and of a modest style and natural colour. Bright, obvious or 'unnatural' hair colours are not permitted. Hairstyling products such as non-coloured gel, wax, mousse etc. can be used to style hair in a neat and tidy manner but must not be used to create exaggerated hairstyles, for example, spikes.

If a hairstyle contravenes these requirements, the student will be requested to amend this with immediate effect, where possible.

Blue or white ankle socks

Black shoes (no trainers)

Navy blue pullover or jacket with GEMS JPS logo (seasonal)

House colour GEMS JPS hat

Year 1 to Year 6

JPS shorts or JPS checked dress or JPS skort

White short-sleeve shirt or blouse with GEMS JPS logo

JPS blue tie or JPS tartan necktie

Blue or white ankle socks

Navy tights (seasonal)

Black shoes (no trainers or heels)

Navy blue pullover or jacket with JPS logo (seasonal)

House colour JPS hat

Please note:

Jewellery, other than a wristwatch and stud earrings, is not permitted.

Children with pierced ears must wear small stud(s) and remove earrings for PE and swimming.

Make-up and nail polish are not acceptable.

PE Kit:

GEMS JPS PE shorts

GEMS JPS polo shirt with GEMS JPS logo in house colour

GEMS JPS hat in house colour

White sports ankle socks

Predominantly white trainers (no laces in Foundation Stage)

Swimming Kit:

GEMS JPS house colour or navy blue swimming trunks/one-piece swimsuit

Swim cap in house colour or plain navy blue

Towel

Swimming goggles (recommended when water confident)

School Bags:

GEMS JPS school rucksack/book bag

GEMS JPS swimming/PE bag in house colour

Snack box – preferably an insulated cooler bag
